to me in Land paid at and before the sealing of these

in the State aforesaid (the parties whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release, unto the said The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, etc.,
successors and assigns.

All my right, title and interest in and to that certain
lot of land aforesaid, lying and being on Hammond Street in
the City of Greenville, and being more particularly described
as follows:

Beginsing at an iron pin on the Northeast side of
Hammond Street, and running thence South 36° 4' East 100
feet to an iron pin on said street, thence North 38° 55' East
191.6' to an iron pin on an unnamed street, thence with
said unnamed street N. 30° 30' W. 103.4 feet to an iron pin,
thence S. 38° 55' W. 204.3 feet to the beginning corner.

Together with the right to tie to the well as set forth
in the deed to the Grantor, which deed is recorded in Volume
68 at page 83.
