(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Emma Burton (my wife) her heirs and assigns:

All my interest in

All that piece, parcel and lot of land situate in the State and County aforesaid and in the city of Greenville near the Freight Depot of the Southern Railway Company, fronting on Railroad street and having the followingmetes and bounds and courses and distances to-wit: Beginning at a stake on right of way of said Railway Company, fifty feet north of street running East and West and running thence N. 85½ E. one hundred and twenty feet to a stake; thence N. 4½ W. Eighty feet to a stake; thence S. 85½ W. one hundred and twenty feet to a stake on R. R. purchase; thence S. 4½ E. fifty feet to the beginning corner. Containing Twenty-two perches and known as lot No. 8 of survey made by J. K. Dickson, and being the same lot of land conveyed to Cagle Counts by Emma Brown by deed bearing date the 2nd day of February 1892, and recorded in the office of the Register Mesne Conveyance for said county in Book Y. Y. page 128, and and being the same land in which Carrie Counts and others conveyed to Sallie Harris (formerly Sallie Counts) their interest by deed recorded in the said office of Book O.O.O. page 449 and conveyed to U. B. Gross by Sallie Harris by deed bearing date March 4th, 1912 and recorded in said office in Vol. 19, page 537.

This being the same lot of land conveyed to Alexander Burton and Emma Burton by C. B. Gross by deed dated the 11th day of February, 1918, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County Vol. 42, page 294.
