M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H", at page 182.

Also all rights, titles and interest which the grantor may have in the rightsof-way of said water lines on, over, across, and through any and all of the property
described above, together with a pump and pumping station located upon the said property
and used for the purpose of furnishing water to the said property.

It is specifically understood and agreed, however, that the grantee is to permit the owners of any lots shown upon the said plat or any person who may become the owner thereof by reason of any mortgages or by other regular means to tap and connect with the said water line free of charge and to have the use and benefit of the pump and pumping station herein referred to without charge or obligation, provided that nothing herein contained shall be construed to mean that the grantee shall not have the right to charge a resonable rate for water so used; provided also that such charges for gater shall be
