to me paid by J. W. Campbellin the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said J. W. Campbell

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in _____ Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the state and County aforesaid. Both sides of Goodpon road and on the branch waters of middle Upper River adjoining lands of G. E. Reunion, E. F. Campbell, W. L. Lanford and others:

Beginning on a stone and running thence S. 34° 21' E. 7.67 to a stone on west side of Goodpon road, thence S. 34° 21' E. 5.81 along said road to stone on W. side of said road on G. E. Reunion line, thence along his line S 80° 21' E. 2.90 to a stone in place of cedar, thence another of his lines S 66° 08' 21' E. 9.14 to a stone, thence N. 34° 21' E. 24.09 to stone on west side of Howansville road crossing small branch on way, thence N 13° 1/2' E. 6.32 to a large flint rock on west side of Howansville road and on E. F. Campbell's line, thence N 82° 1/4' E. 12.85 to a chestnut stump on S side of Goodpon road, thence S. 44° E. 4.15 to a stone on W side of said Goodpon road, thence S. 64° E. 10.3 to a stone, thence S. 53° 1/4' E. 6.53 to beginning corner containing 53.35 acres more or less. And being the same land conveyed to me by E. S. Dill by deed dated December 20th 1911 and recorded in office of R. M. C. Greenville County in Vol 17 page 304.

Also all that other piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in the state and County aforesaid, Three Mountain Township, joining lands of J. D. Lanford, Fulman Campbell, W. L. Lanford, W. J. Campbell and George Campbell, and having the following meter and bounds to wit:-

Beginning at a stone on south bank of the Goodpon road, thence N. 35° 1/2' N. 5.75 chs to a stone on bank of said road, thence N. 34° E. 7.40 chs to stone, thence S. 85° E. 17.84 chs to stone, thence S. 19° 21' E. 22.80 chs to stone on south side of Goodpon road, thence a straight line running to the beginning corner on south bank of said Goodpon road, and containing 40 acres more or less. And being the same land conveyed to me by J. L. Hawkins by deed dated April 10th 1919 and recorded in office of R. M. C. Greenville County in Vol 45 page 416.
