Whereas, Home Building and Loan Association, of Greenville, South Carolina, did on or about December 11th, 1933, file its Bill of Complaint in the District Court of the United States for the Western District of South Carolina against United States of America, Robert L. Woodside and Lula B. Woodside, defendants, demanding judgment in regard to the real estate and certain personal property hereinafter mentioned and described, and such proceedings resulted in a decree dated July 20, 1934, directing that said properties hereinabove mentioned be sold by John L. Plyler, Special Master, on the terms and for the purposes set forth in said decree, and John L. Plyler, Special Master having advertised said properties to be sold as provided in said decree on August 20, 1934, and did then publicly and openly, according to the custom of auction, sell and dispose of the same to Home Building and Loan Association, for the sum of \$11,500.00, being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

Now, Therefore, Know all men by these Presents, that I, John L. Plyler, Special Master in and for the United States District Court for the Western District of South Carolina, in consideration of the sum of Eleven Thousand, Five Hundreds (\$11,500.00) Dollars to me paid by the said Home Building and Loan Association, a Corporation, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Home Building and Loan Association, a Corporation, the following described real estate: "All that piece, parcel and lot of land situated in Ward 4 of the City of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the south side of East Washington Street, and lying between Mordecai and Neldman Street.

Beginning at an iron pin on the southeast corner of East Washington Street and Mordecai Street, and running thence along Mordecai Street, S. 19° W. 170 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 70° E. 62 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 19° E. 170 feet to an iron pin on East Washington Street, thence with Washington Street 60 feet to the beginning corner.

Also:

All that lot of land situated in the city and county of Greenville being a portion of Lot No. 8 in Block 6 of a plat of Boyce land, and described as follows:
