Your petitioner respectfully shows to the Master:

1.
That your petitioner, Annie Shackleton, is the widow of N. W. Shackleton, deceased, who died on or about 1935, intestate, leaving as his sole heir at law your petitioner, Annie Shackleton, and the following children: Nathaniel W. Shackleton, age eighteen; Annie Ruth Shackleton, age thirteen; Helen Frances Shackleton, age eleven; Billie Shackleton, age eight; and Alva Shackleton, age seven.

That the said N. W. Shackleton owned at the time of his death one lot of land in the City of Greenville, described as follows:

"All that lot of land in Greenville County, South Carolina, in ward five of the City of Greenville, on the north side of Lumberburg Avenue, known as lot no. 8 of L. A. Miller property as shown on plat Book H, page 118. Beginning on the north side of Lumberburg Avenue, joint corner of lots 7 and 8, and running thence S. 53-0 E. 957.2 feet to an iron pin at joint corner of lots 7 and 8; thence S 21-28 W. 49.5 feet along line of J. W. Berry to an iron pin; thence along rear line of lots 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 N. 53-0 E. 170.5 feet to an iron pin on Lumberburg Avenue; thence N. 37-0 E. 48 feet to beginning."

That your petitioner is now the head of the family and entitled to an estate of homestead in the real property above described in the amount of one thousand dollars. No process has been lodged against said homestead and your petitioner is therefore entitled to have same set off in accordance with the Statutory laws of the State of South Carolina, as set out in Code of 1932, Volume 3, Section 9094.

Wherefore your petitioner prays that the Master duly advertise, appraise, and take such other steps as are necessary to set aside a homestead in that lot of land located in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina.
