H. Langley, and whereas the said Pure Oil Company of the Carolinas in consideration of a payment of fifty (50) per cent of the face amount of said judgment desires to release the premises hereinafter described from the lien of said judgment, now therefore,

Know all Men by these Presents that for and in consideration of the payment above described (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) the said Pure Oil Company of the Carolinas, Inc. hereby releases the lien of the above described judgment as to the premises described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the north side of Mahon Street in subdivision known as Park Place just beyond the incorporate limits of the city of Greenville, in Greenville Township, in Greenville County, in the State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot # 13, Block "C" as shown by plat of the Park Place subdivision recorded in the office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at Page 119; being bounded on the north by alley as shown by said plat, on the east by lot # 14 shown on said plat property now or formerly of Chas. W.
