do commission, constitute and appoint you the said
J. J. Seyle, member of the Westville Water and Sewer Sub-Dis-
trict Committee in the State aforesaid, to have, hold, exercise
and enjoy the said office of member of Committee aforesaid,
together with all the rights, privileges, profits and emoluments
whatsoever thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining.

This Commission is to continue in force for the
term provided by law. (Four years)
