City of Greenville, its successors and assigns:

All that lot or strip of land, situate on the southwest side of East North Street, in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the east side of Spring Street at the corner of lot now owned by the grantor, which corner is at the intersection of said Street with east North Street and runs thence along east North Street S. 70 degrees, 42 minutes E. 124.2 feet; thence S. 18 degrees, 36 minutes W. 5.92 feet to a corner; thence N. 70 degrees, 39 minutes W. 124.3 feet to a point on the East side of said Spring Street; thence with said Street N. 19 degrees, 18 minutes E. 5.8 feet to the beginning corner, and being a strip of land along the entire Northeasterly side of the premises described in that certain deed from E. Inman, Master, to The Prudential Insurance Company of America dated September 23, 1933, and recorded September 25, 1933 in Book J, Page 360 in the office of the auditor of Greenville County, South Carolina, said strip being 5.8 feet at the Northwesterly end and 5.92 feet at the Southeasterly end.

This strip of land is conveyed to the City of Greenville for the purpose of widening East North Street and for street purposes only.
