(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

H. F. Loggins, his heirs and assigns forever:

All our right, title and interest in and to all
that piece of land or lot of land, in Greenville Town-
ship, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known
and designated as Lot no 18, 19 and 20 on the R. C.
Martin property according to a plat of the same
made by R. C. Dalton, Esq., February 13, 1928 and re-
corded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville, South Caro-
lina Book F at page 162, and having as com-
monly said plat the following metes and bounds:
Beginning at an iron pin at the north
east intersection of Taris Road and Argonne
Drive, and running thence with said Taris
Road, N. 69-50 E. 116.50 feet to a pin at that
intersection of said Taris Road and a 20-foot
alley, thence with said 20-foot alley, S. 71-13-6
1.3257 feet to a pin corner of Lot no 15, thence
with line of lot no 15, S. 41-40 E. 83.6 feet to a pin
corner of lot 17; thence with line of lot no 17, S.
48-50 W. 117.5 feet to a pin on Argonne Drive,
thence with said Argonne Drive N. 41-10-24. 236.8
feet to the beginning corner.

This land was deeded to H. F. Loggins
and Ora C. Loggins by Lucile W. Benson by deed
dated Dec 31st, 1928 and recorded in Deed Book
148 at page 208.
