(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

W. F. Loggins, his heirs and assigns forever:

All our right, title and interest in and to all that piece parcel or lot of land in Greenville Town and Greenville County, State of South Carolina known and designated as Lots nos 18, 19 and 20 on the E. Martin property according to a plat of the same made by R. E. Walton, Esq. February 1914 and recorded in the E. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book F at page 162, and having according to said plat the following metered boundaries to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin at the north-east intersection of Jarvis Road and Argonne Drive, and running thence with said Jarvis Road, N. 69-50 E. 116.50 feet to a pin at that intersection of said Jarvis Road and a 20-foot alley, thence with said 20-foot alley, S. 71-35 E. 132.7 feet to a pin corner of Lot no 15, thence with line of lot no 15, S. 41-40 E. 83.6 feet to a pin corner of lot 17, thence with line of lot no 17 S. 48-50 W. 47.5 feet to a pin on Argonne Drive, thence with said Argonne Drive N. 41-10 W. 236.8 feet to the beginning corner.

This land was deeded to W. F. Loggins and Ora C. Loggins by Lucile W. Benson by deed dated Dec 31st, 1928 and recorded in Deed Book 148 at page 208.

The interest herein conveyed is the interest we inherited from her at her death.
