COURT OF COMMON PLEAS.

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Ms. Annie Belle Chamblee, as Administratrix of the Estate of G. E.

Chamblee, deceased,

on or about the 31st day of August in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty four exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against T. S. Thackston, et al.

Demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 15th day of October 1934 and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

for sale by public outcry on the 5th day of November in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty four did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auctions, sell and dispose of the same unto W. M. Satterfield

for the sum of Nine Hundred (\$900.00) Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Nine Hundred (\$900.00) Dollars to me paid by the said W. M. Satterfield,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. M. Satterfield,

"All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone on the East side of road and running thence N. 62-45 W. 15.32 chains to stone; thence S. 23-00 W. 25.00 chains to iron pin N. E.; thence by a new line N. 70-25 E. 6.77 chains to iron pin; thence S. 80-00 E. 8.04 chains to pin in road; thence along said road N. 13-15 E. 4.00 chains to pin; thence S. 75-00 E. 5.09 chains to pin on old line; thence N. 16-15 E. 11.00 chains to pin; thence N. 78-20 E. 7.09 chains to post oak stump; thence N. 40-00 W. 7.45 chains to the beginning corner and containing 36.85 acres, more or less.

Said land being the same conveyed to T. S. Thackston by T. O. Thackston by deed dated February 10, 1922, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 75, Page 122; and being a part of the tract of land conveyed to T. S. Thackston and T. O. Thackston by W. M. Garrett by deed dated December 15, 1910, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 9, Page 349."
