the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said P. F. Cureton,

"All that tract of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the north side of Augusta Street, Beginning at corner of Dr. W. E. Scott's line; thence with Augusta Street N. 39 3/4 E. 48 feet to stake; thence N. 53-30 W. 87 feet to stake; thence S. 69 W. 42 feet to stake; thence S. 22 E. 25.5 feet to stake corner of a barn in Scott's line; thence with Scott's line, S. 53-30 E. 87 feet to the beginning, and being the same property conveyed to A.
