J. Bridges, W. M. Hunt and Luther Donaldson on the south by lands of Luther Donaldson and W. J. Weaver and W. J. Bridges and Marshbank, and having according to a survey and plat made by C. M. Garrison Engr. September 4, 1934, the following
