piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying, and being Greenville  
County, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated  
as lot no 40 of Leamilla Park Addition on Map No. 1 thereof, made by Dalton & Myers for Title Guarantee and Trust Co. dated December 1927, and having  
according to said plat, the following metes and bounds to wit:  
Beginning at a stake on the south east side of the Easley Bridge  
Road eighty (80) feet southward from the south corner of said
