Know all men by these presents: That the undersigned, of said County and State hereinafter called Granter, for and in consideration of the terms, conditions and privileges hereinefter expressed, and the sum of One (31.00) Dollar to the Granter in hand paid by PARKER Water and Seast Sub-District, of Greenville, South Caroline, the receipt whereaf, is hereby acknowledged, so hereby grant unto the said Grantee, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon that track or lot of land situate in Greenville Township, in said County and State, and described as follows:

and to construct, maintain in and upon and use in and through said premises, in a proper manner, with necessary apparatus and appliances suon as machinery, air conts, menholes, blow-off connections and any and every other necessary and proper attachment, pipe lines, for water and severage purposes through the premises above described, together with the right at all times to enter in and upon said premises for the purpose of ingpecting and making necessary repairs and alterations of said line, together with the right to out away and keep clear of said pipe lines all trees and other obstructions that may in any way endanger the proper operations of same.

It is unierstood and agreed; That the easement herein granted shall extend throughout the property of the Granter about 50 feet, and shall be of such width as the Grantee shall deem necessary for the purposes herein specified, and that the damage for which said Grantes may be held liable shall be confined to that arising from the use of this strip only, and nothing beyond.
