Coker, as Special Laster as aforesaid, William Elliott and Robert Gage as Receivers of PeoPles State Bank of South Carolina, under and pursuant to the authority and power conferred upon us by the several orders of court hereinabove referred to, and for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Thousand (315,000.00) Dollars to us in hand paid by the said J. C. Cunningham, his heirs at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. C. Cunningham, his and assigns;

All that certain lot of land with the buildings thereon, situate on the northwest corner of the intersection of Trade and Victoria Streets in the Town of Greer, Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, having the following mates and bounds, Beginning at a stake on said corner and running thence along Trade Street N. 13 2 W. thirty three (33') feet to J. C. Cunningham building; thence S. 772 W. along the line or said J. C. Cunningham lot ninety (90') feet to a stake; thence S. 132 E. along J. C.
