It is further agreed as part of the consideration for the execution hereof that the grantors herein and their heirs, successors and assigns may, at their own expense, make such taps or connections with any and all of said pipe lines as they may desire; provided, however, that such taps or connections shall be made only under the rules and supervision of the engineers representing said grantee or its successors. Said grantee, by accepting this deed, binds itself and its successors to construct, at its and their own expense, man-holes at all points where said grantors or either of them or their respective heirs, successors or assigns may desire to connect with said pipe lines; also to make good all loss or damage which may be caused at any time or times to persons, crops and other property by accident to said pipe lines or any of them or by any act or neglect on the part of said grantee or its agents, servants, employees, successors or assigns.

The payments and privileges above specified are hereby accepted in full settlement of all claims and damages for said easement, except as herein above stated.
