dition (in which case this lease shall continue as though no such injury had occurred) and the rent shall be abated or reasonably diminished during the period in which such building shall remain untenantable; or whether he will not so repair and restore said building (in which event he shall w ithin said period of two weeks give written notice of such election to said lessee, who will at once remove and surrender possession of such premises) and in such event this lease shall immediately become null and void.

And it is further agreed that in the event of litigation or disagreement regarding any of the terms of this lease or the occupancy of said premises or any other matter relating thereto it shall be lawful for any Judge of the Court of Common Pleas for said State, upon application to him, ex parte or otherwise, on behalf of said owner, at chambers or in open Court, either in or nut of the County of Greenville, to appoint, without notice to said lesse a receiver for said premises, to take possession thereof, or to collect the rents thereof and hold the same for the benefit of said owner pending such litigation or until the adjustment of such disagreement.

And it is further agreed that the terms and conditions hereof shall extend to and bind the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the parties hereto, respectively.
