ordered to sell the tract of land owned by the Bankrupt in Gneal Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and more fully described in said order of sale.

The property was advertised for sale in the Greenville News, a newspaper of general circulation published in Greenville County, South Carolina for three consecutive weeks, beginning May 11, 1935, said notice appearing in the issues of the Greenville News of May 11, May 18, and May 25, 1935 and through inadvertence or error on the part of the newspaper, said notice was omitted from the issue on June 1, 1935, but was run in the issue of the Greenville Piedmont of June 1, 1935. The attorney for the Bankrupt and the attorneys for all of the lien creditors consented to waive this irregularity and allow the sale to be held. I therefore conducted the sale at the Greenville County Court House on Monday, June 3, 1935 as called for in the notice, at which sale the property was bid in by the Atlantic Joint Stock Land Bank of Raleigh for Three thousand three hundred (\$3300.00) Dollars, it being at that price the highest bidder therefor. The property was sold free from liens with the understanding that the purchaser would receive the rents for 1935, and would pay the taxes for 1935.

The property sold was appraised at \$2670.00. The amount of the bid therefore exceeded the appraised value thereof.

I respectfully recommend that the above sale be confirmed, and pray that the Court issue an order waiving the irregularity in the advertisement and confirming the sale and such further orders as are proper.
