This day of January in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten, I, H. H. Morris, do hereby convey unto Mary E. Sutherland, my wife, all my right, title and interest in and to the following described real estate, which is described in the Deed of Sale and Release made by me to J. W. Perry, dated May 12th, 1923, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "F" at page 127.

Mary E. Sutherland, my heirs and assigns;

All those certain lots or parcels of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, S. C., on the North side of Marlin Street, near the Paris Mountain Road, known and designated as lots Nos. 45, 47 and 48, on plat of the property of J. W. Perry Estate, which is of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "F" at page 127.

Lot 45 on said plat has the following mates and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Marlin Street, which iron pin is at the joint corner of lots 45 and 46, and running thence with the North side of Marlin Street, N. 58-30 E. 50 feet to an iron pin, corner of lots 44 and 45; thence with the joint line of said lots N. 31-30 W. 150 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 23, 24, 44 and 45; thence with the joint line of lots 23 and 45, S. 58-30 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of lots 22, 23 and 45 and 46; thence with the line of lot 46, S. 31-30 E. 150 feet to Marlin Street, the point of beginning.

Lots 47 and 48 on said plat, as described together, have the following mates and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Marlin Street, which iron pin is the joint corner of lots 46 and 47, and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 31-30 W. 150 feet to an iron pin, rear joint corner of lots 21, 22, 46 and 47; thence along the rear line of lots 10, 20 and 21, S. 58-30 W. 131 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Laurel Street; thence along the East side of said Street S. 55-54 E. 164.6 feet to an iron pin at the Northeast corner of the intersection of Marlin and Laurel Sts.; thence along the North side of Marlin Street, N. 58-30 S. 52.7 ft. to the beginning corner.
