(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
North Greenville Baptist Academy,

An undivided seven-ninths (7/9ths) of one half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) interest of, in and to that  
certain lot of land in the Town of Greer, Chick Springs Township, said County and State,  
(with the improvements thereon) beginning at a point on South Trade Street, on the South  
side thereof, formerly the L. L. Merchant corner, and runs thence S.  $78\frac{1}{2}$  W. 2.91 to stone;  
thence S. 13 E.  $72\frac{3}{4}$  links to a point; thence N.  $78\frac{1}{2}$  S. 2.91 to stone on said Trade Street;  
thence N. 12 W.  $72\frac{3}{4}$  links to the beginning corner, containing one-fourth of an acre, more or  
less, together with alley-way ten feet wide extending from Victoria Street at rear of lot  
of Greer Bank to the rear of above lot, which alleyway is agreed by J. H. Payne in deed of  
Jan. 9, 1893 to be kept open. The said lot fronts 50 feet on Trade Street.

Also, same interest in lot adjoining the above lot, on the southside thereof,  
beginning at a point on Trade Street, corner of above lot, and runs thence with said Street  
southward 2 feet 1 inch to formerly Waltrip's corner; thence along the former Waltrip line  
N. 78 W. 90 feet to an alley; thence Northward 2 feet 1 inch to the line of the first de-  
scribed lot above; thence along said line eastward 90 feet to the beginning corner. The  
two above lots together front 52 feet 1 inch on Trade Street, measuring from the former  
L. L. Merchant corner.

The interest hereby conveyed is an undivided (7/9ths) seven-ninths of my one-half  
undivided interest in said property.
