All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated lying on Waters of South Tiger River near O'Neal in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Beginning on Stone Southeast of the house; thence N. 44° E. 8.10 to ch iron pin; thence N. 14° S. 6.00 ch. to a stone; thence N. 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 12.00 ch. to ston on branch; thence N. 70° W. 3.75 ch. to a stake; thence south 73° N. 3.00 ch. to stake; thence S. 35° E. 75 links to a stone; thence S. 41° W. 3.18 ch. to a stone; thence S. 45° W. 4.30 ch. to a stone; thence S. 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 2.50 ch. to a stone; thence N. 37° W. 2.70 ch. to R. O. thence S. 41° W. 6.27 to a stone; thence S. 45° S. 2.50 ch. to a stake; thence S. 36° W. 2.00 ch. to stake; thence S. 4° S. 6.00 ch. to a stone; thence S. 88° S. 21.50 ch. to the beginning corner, and containing Forty two (42) acres, more or less, and being bounded by lands of Perry Smith, J. T. Paris Estate, I. P. Reese Estate and others and being all of the same tract of land conveyed to me by deed of said Rosa L. West on September 30th, 1933, as recorded in deed Book or Vol. 171 Page 186, in office of R. M.
