Lewis M. Verdin the following described property, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate lying and being in Butler
Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the North side of the Pelham Road, adjoining
lands of Wealthy H. Green, R. A. Peace, J. A. Hamby and L. M. Verdin, containing 50
acres, more or less, and having the following mates and bounds, courses and distances,
to-wit: according to a plat and survey made by J. J. Riddle, Surveyor, November 18, 1833.

Beginning at a stone on the Pelham Road corner of property of L. M. Verdin and
other property of J. A. Hamby and running thence with line of J. A. Hamby N. 15 W. 3.05 cns.
to stone; thence N. 6 W. 7.16 cns. to an iron pin; thence N. 3-30 W. 6.11 cns. to iron pin;
thence N. 15 E. 7.39 cns. to iron pin; thence N. 67-30 W. 18.23 cns. to stone; thence S.
62 W. 11.79 cns. thence S. 39-45 E. 6.32 cns. to stone; thence S. 15-30 E. 11.51 cns. to a
stake; thence S. 56-36 E. 2.50 cns. to stone; thence S. 69-30 E. 19.85 cns. to the beginning
corner.
