The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Considered, Examined, Sold and Passsed, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Particulars unto the said

Lizzie Cocksey, her heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel and lot of
land situate lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County and State of South
Carolina, in Ward 3 of the City of Greenville; Beginning at a point on Broad Street 50
feet from the corner of Broad and Jackson Streets, and running thence in an easterly
direction 58 feet to the corner of Donalson property; thence at right angles to this
line 100 feet to a 10 foot alley; thence in a westerly direction with said alley 58 feet
to a point 50 feet from Jackson Street; thence in a southerly direction and at right angles
to this line 100 feet to the beginning corner.

Also all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being situate in
Ward 3 of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid.

Beginning at the northeast corner of Broad and Jackson Streets and running thence
with Broad Street in an easterly direction 50 feet, thence at right angles to first line
100 feet to a ten foot alley; thence in a westerly direction with said alley 50 feet to
Jackson Street; thence with Jackson Street in a southerly direction 100 feet to the
beginning corner.

The above two lots are the same conveyed to me by Thos. T. Goldsmith by deed dated
