All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the  
City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, being known and designated as lot #2, Block  
4, Boyce's addition to Greenville as shown on plat recorded in R. A. C. Office in plat book  
A, at page 178 and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, courses  
and distances, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Boyce Avenue which iron pin is at the  
South west corner of the intersection of Boyce Avenue and a ten foot alley, running thence  
along the south side of said alley S. 76-45 W. 105 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 13  
E. 29 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 76-45 E.  
S. 135 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Boyce Avenue; thence with the West side of  
said Avenue N. 16 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed  
to the grantor herein by deed of J. Clyde Peeler dated Feb. 23, 1935, and recorded in the  
R. A. C. office for Greenville County in deeds, Volume 178, at page 415.

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance the grantee herein assumes and
