Nora P. Neill, her heirs and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the  
State and County aforesaid in Highland Township, on waters of Pax's Creek, of South  
Tyger River, and containing seventy-seven acres, more or less, and being a part of the  
Prince Land, conveyed to J. P. Ballenger by Srma Prince Harrison by deed dated Nov. 27,  
1935, and recorded in the R. S. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 38, at page  
361."

This property is the same conveyed to J. M. Wells, as Receiver for Fannie C.
