L. G. Campbell and his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville on the north side of Randall Street in the City of Greenville and being known as a portion of lot 23 in section A of property of the Stone Land Company and more specifically described as to courses and distances as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point on the N. side of Randall Street 283 feet from the corner of Milton St. and running thence with property formerly known as the Walker property but now Pearl C. Higgins M. 6-47 S. 112 8 feet to a stake, thence N. 79-30 W. 53.25 feet to a stake, thence S. 6-47 W. 112 feet more or less to a stake on Randall St., thence S. 83-13 E. 53 feet along Randall St. to the beginning corner.
