Lease with Options to Buy

This agreement entered into this August 3, 1935,
by and between Frank M. Guinn and Mary H. Guinn,
hereinafter referred to as party of the first part,
and L. C. Dillinger, hereinafter referred to as party
of the second part,

Witnesseth, that, in consideration of the rental
hereinafter mentioned, the party of the first part
have granted, bargained and sold, and by these
presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the party
of the second part for a term of one year a portion
of Lot no. 6 of the Block of property as shown by a
plat recorded in Plat Book C, at page 105, R. M. L.
Office for Greenville County, State aforesaid, said
lot being on Mountain View Avenue, said being
the same lot conveyed to them by W. J. Cain on
May 28, 1935 by deed recorded in Vol. 79, page 376,
R. M. L. Office for Greenville County, State aforesaid,
and the party of the second part, in consideration
for the use of said premises for the said term,
promises to pay to the said lessors the sum of
Dollars (\$50.00) cash and in addition thereto, the sum
of forty-five Dollars (\$45.00) on October 1, 1935 and a
like amount on the first day of each succeeding
month until the amounts set forth below shall
have been paid in full and in the manner pre-
scribed.

As a part of the considerations of this lease, it
is further agreed that the party of the second part
shall have the option to purchase the above described
premises at a sum of four thousand, Two
Hundred and Forty Dollars (\$4,260.00) and that all
payments heretofore made, to wit, the sum of Fifty Dollars
(\$50.00) cash and the further sum of forty-five
Dollars (\$45.00) paid each month shall be applied
upon the purchase price to follow as follows:

Thirty-one dollars (\$31.00) each month shall be
applied upon the payment of a certain mortgage
executed by the parties, by the first part herein, to
the First Federal Savings and Loan Association of
Greenville, South Carolina, recorded in Vol. 25, page
166, R. M. L. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.
Seventeen Dollars (\$17.00) shall be paid upon a certain
note of even date with the premises above set forth by
the party of the second part to the party of the first part
in the sum of One Thousand Four Hundred and
Sixty-six Dollars and Seven and Seven-tenths cents
(\$1,146.74) with interest upon the amount of said
note at the rate of six per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid quarterly and interest not paid
when due to bear interest at the same rate as the
principal.

It is further agreed that, so long as the pay-
ments of the sum of forty-five Dollars (\$45.00) per
month shall be made without default of more than
thirty days, this lease shall be termed as a lease from
year to year, and all payments made hereunder
shall be applied to the purchase price of Four
Thousand, Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$4,260.00)
as named above, but should the party of the second
part become more than thirty days in arrears upon
the payments as set forth herein, or fail to pay taxes
and fire insurance premiums or to make necessary
