"All that tract of land lying on East side of Augusta Road, County of Greenville, beginning at an iron pin corner of lots No. 76 and 77, running thence N. 60 degrees 47 min E. 265.5 to a stake in Granada Street, thence S. 5 degrees 43 min. E. 150 feet more or less to a stake in Granada Street, thence S. 60 degrees 47 min W. 50 feet more or less, to a stake; the back corner of lots No. 79 and 80, thence along the back line of lots No. 79 and 78 N. 29 degrees 13 min.
