(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Louisa Jamison for and during her natural Life,
Our interest in all that piece, parcel or lot of land
situate lying and being in Ward Six of the City of
Greenville, State of South Carolina, on Nichols and
Robinson Streets, Beginning at a stake at the corner
of Nichols and Robinson Streets, thence along Nichols
Street One Hundred (100) feet to a stake; thence parallel
with Robinson Street One Hundred (100) feet to a
stake; thence parallel with Nichols Street One Hun-
dred (100) feet to a stake on Robinson Street; thence
along Robinson Street One Hundred (100) feet to the
beginning corner. This is the land conveyed to John
