because in said deed there was a dividing line described between two tracts of land lying together, said dividing line being eldmated herein and because of a slight change in the line between this tract of land an an adjoining tract of land owned by R. G. Smith, said change having been agreed upon between Smith and myself after his Surveyor, Mr. Joe Atkins, established the exact line for Smith.

This said tract of land herein conveyed to C. E. Sloan being bounded on the North by lands of R. G. Smith on the East by Lands of A. B. Cannon, et al. on the South by Lands of George W. Few and on the West by Lands of J. W. Black, et al.
