(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Maye H. Webb, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville on Augusta Street, about one and one-eighth acres there being in said Street House, and having the following mates and corners to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Augusta Street, at the corner a lot formerly owned by George Brownlee, and running thence with Augusta Street S. 20° 20' E. 50 feet, inches to an iron pin, thence N. 81° 40' E. 194 feet, to another iron pin, thence N. 10° 45' W. 50 feet, to another iron pin, thence S. 40° W. 201 feet to the beginning corner.

Also, all those three certain tracts of land situated, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville in Greenville Township, on waters of Golden Goose Creek, aggregating 2.99 acres, more or less, and each of said tracts being minutely described by metes and bounds set forth in a deed made to H. B. Tindal therefore by J. F. Donald and J. Walter Harrison, Executors of the estate of George F. Donald, dated the 18th day of March, 1910 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Vol 8 page 59, to which reference is here made for a more detailed description, and is a part of the description being

Also, all those three certain tracts of land in Ward Six of the City of Greenville, being described as follows: No 1. Commencing at a point on the south side of Crescent Avenue, corner of lot no 30, as shown on map of Crescent Terrace made by P. E. Dalton, Engineer, July 1919, thence with Crescent Avenue S. 84° 40' W. 140 feet to a post on Crescent Avenue N.E. corner of home place of Mrs. Stella K. Tindal; thence S. 5° 41' E. 200 feet to an alley, thence with alley N. 84° 40' E. 140 feet to a point on line of lot no 30, thence with line of said lot, N. 5° 41' W. to the beginning corner.

No 2. Commencing on the south side of an alley on Cooper Street 210 feet from N.E. corner of Crescent Avenue and Cooper Street, thence with Cooper Street 200 feet to corner of lot no 77 as shown on said plat, thence with line of lot no 77, N. 84° 40' E. 200 feet to a stake, thence N. 5° 41' W. 200 feet to a point on alley, thence with alley, S. 84° 40' W. 200 feet to the beginning corner.

No 3. All of lot no 20 as shown by plat aforesaid on the north side of Crescent Avenue, said lot being shown on said plat as having a frontage of 70 feet with a depth of 295.9 feet, excepting however a stoop of five feet in width extending along the west side of said lot.

As a consideration for this conveyance the grantee herein agrees to satisfy and cancel of record 3 mortgages which the grantee holds to secure an indebtedness of \$22,000.00 presented by note dated Jan 12, 1927. Said note is paid being as follows:
