(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Fred C. Bates, his heirs and assigns forever.

All that pieces parcel or lot of land in Greenville
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina
in Ward 1 of the City of Greenville, on the East side
of Buncombe Street, and being known and designated
as Lot no. 3 according to plat of W. A. Adams, Surveyor,
recorded in Plat Book 6, page 149, R. M.C. Office for
Greenville County, and being more particularly described
as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side
of Buncombe Street 49 feet, back south of the corner
of Goodwin and Buncombe Streets, and running thence
with Buncombe Street S. 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 49 feet, back; thence
N. 70 E. 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet, 6 inches to stake at rear corner of
Lot no. 3; thence in line of Lot no. 3, N. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 47 feet,
6 inches to stake, thence with a 10 foot alley, and
with line of Lot no. 1, S. 69 W. 140 feet to the beginning
corner. With the right to use the 10 foot alley as shown
on said Plat.
