(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. L. Hall, J. G. Sims, and A. E. Brown, as Trustees of The Paris Mountain Holiness Baptist Church:

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate near the City of Greenville in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, known and designated as Lots Nos. 38, 39, 40 and 41, on plat of Paris Piney Park made by C. M. Furman, Jr. Engineer, June, 1926, and having, according to said plat, which is of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book H, page 19, the following metes and bounds,

to-wit:
Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Apopka Avenue at joint corner of Lots 37 and 38, and running thence along the south side of Apopka Avenue 200 feet to an iron pin at joint corner of Lots 41 and 42; thence with the joint line of said lots in a southwesterly direction 150 feet to an iron pin at joint rear corner of Lots 41 and 42, 51 and 52; thence along the rear line of lots 41, 40, 39 and 38 200 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of lots 37, 38, 57 and 58; thence with joint line of lots 37 and 38 150 feet in a northeasterly direction to the south side of Apopka Avenue, the beginning corner.

This being a portion of the property conveyed to the grantor by deed of E. Inman, Master for Greenville County, which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deeds Volume 177, at page 183.
