R. R. S., Justice in Greenville County, S. C. in Vol. 157, page 433.

DEED I do hereby give, grant, convey, sell, lease, and release unto the said

James D. Bates,

the power whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

James D. Bates, and his heirs and assigns forever

All that place, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and  
County aforesaid and is a portion of the land deeded to D. H. Bates by Susie Stewart, et al  
and also all the the tract deeded to D. H. Bates by S. C. Dixon by deed recorded in vol.  
11, Page 277, and tract No. 1 has the following metes and bounds to-wit:- Beginning at  
stone 3x. c.m. at current shrubs 3x, and runs thence according to deed from D. H. Bates  
the following course: N. 2-15 W. 20-15 to a stone; thence N. 57-15 E. 2.62 chs. to stone thence  
N. 22-15 W. 24-50 chs. to stone; thence S. 57-0 W. 22.70 chs. to apple tree; thence S. 65-30  
W. 3.55 chs. to a small mulberry on Dr. wood line; thence with that line S. 9-30 E. 207 ft.  
to a new stone 3x on new division line; thence S. 34-30 E. 348 ft. to a stone on side of a  
road; thence S. 72-30 E. 100 ft. to an angle; thence S. 22-45 E. 125 ft. to an angle; thence  
S. 73-30 E. 204 ft. and L. P. in road; thence 43-15 E. 200 ft. to a pine; thence S. 73-15  
E. 141 ft. to a stone; thence S. 40-45 E. 200 ft. to a stone; thence S. 53-30 E. 180 ft. to  
a stone; thence S. 15-15 W. 333 ft to a stone near a branch; thence S. 30-45 E. 300 ft. to  
a stone near the branch; thence S. 9-15 crossing branch 80 ft. to a stone; thence S. 19-45  
E. 273 ft. to a stone; thence S. 38-0 E. 185 ft. to a stone; thence S. 28-0 E. 282 ft. to a  
stone on a road and on Stewart's line; thence with old line N. 55-30 E. 365.5 ft. to the  
beginning 3x and contains 53.8 acres, or the same more or less.

Also that other tract No. 2 as described in deed to D. H. Bates from S. C. Dixon,  
Beginning at an iron wood or small mulberry Dr. P. S. Woods, 3x; and runs thence N. 63 E.  
5.54 chs. to an ash stamp thence N. 55 E. 28.85 chs. to rock; thence N. 19 W. 3195 chs. to  
a pine; thence S. 24 W. 13.94 to a mulberry about one chain to the right of the creek;  
thence a straight line to intersect the straight part of the creek; thence S. 25 E. with  
the creek 2.50 chs. to a small cherry; thence S. 19-30 E. 2.27 chs. to the Barton creek;  
thence down the creek to the beginning and contains 76 $\frac{1}{2}$  acres or the same more or less.
