to Mrs. Sarah St. Shacketon, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mrs. Sarah St. Shacketon,

all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Three Mountain Township, lying on the east side of the Buncambe Road, and having, according to a plat of the property of H. C. Potter, made by Dalton & Redick, Engineers, Poterell, 1932, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of the Buncambe Road, and running thence N. 84-45° E. 13.90 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 16-40 E. 615 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 78-10-20. 40.7 feet to a cherry tree, thence S. 19-35 E. 84.3 feet to a Spanish oak stump, thence S. 16-30 E. 567.5 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 87-45-20. 671 feet to an iron pin in the center of road, thence along center of said road N. 21-26-45-20. 36.8 feet to a stone, thence N. 35-05 E. 54 feet to a cast iron ornament, thence N. 46-24-12.3.4 feet to an iron pin in the center of road, thence N. 26-45 N. 361 feet to a stone, thence N. 17-10-20. 23.9 feet to a stone, thence S. 34-05-20. 241 feet to a stone, thence N. 45-46-20. 751.4 feet to a stake in the east side of the Buncambe Road, thence along the east side of the Buncambe Road in a northwesterly direction 513 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, containing 4.0 acres, more or less, and being a portion of the same tract of land conveyed to H. Collye Potter and Minifred R. Potter by Mr. Lawrence re trustee by deed dated December 12, 1934, and recorded in the R.M. Office in Deed Book 43 at page 812.

Also all our right, title and interest in and to a strip of land adjoining the above described tract, now being used as a right of way along the New Buncambe Roads.
