(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
Sarah Finley Bennett, her heirs and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, lying and being situate in the  
County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, containing 46 acres, more or less, and  
having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances:

Beginning on a stone on Sandy Springs Road and running thence N.  $72\frac{1}{2}$  W. 5.50 along  
said road to a stone in road; thence N. 56 W. 2.50 along said road to stone in road; thence  
S. 14 W. 5.00 to stone in road; thence S.  $87\frac{1}{2}$  W. 35.35 to stone; thence S.  $82\frac{1}{2}$  W. 5.35 to  
stone; thence S. 67 E. 6.89 to stone; thence S. 66 E. 34.50 to stone; thence N. 21 W. 2.75  
to stone; thence N. 5 E. 10.13 to the beginning corner, and bounded by lands now or formerly  
belonging to John J. Slaton, Ancrum Fuller, S. A. Wimms and others, and being the same con-  
veyed to Luisa Ann Stanzell by J. J. Slaton by his deed bearing date Nov. 1, 1905, and  
October 1910, and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Books  
HRR and 58 at pages 532 and 205, respectively; and being the same conveyed to the South  
Carolina Savings Bank, as Receiver for the Peoples Bank of Fountain Inn by K. Inman, Master  
for Greenville County, by deed recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in  
Book 462, at page 237, the name of the said bank having been changed to that of the South  
Carolina State Bank by amendment of the charter since the said property was conveyed to it.

This is the same land conveyed to me by deed of South Carolina State Bank, as  
Receiver, dated October 3, 1932, and recorded in volume 121, page 282.
