TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, *Henry Gosnell, et al*

on or about the *10th* day of *August* in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirty-three* exhibited *their* complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against *Benny Gosnell, et al*

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the *13th* day of *December*, 19*33* and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

for sale by public outcry on the *6th* day of *May* in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirty-five*, did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auctions, sell and dispose of the same unto *D. E. Massey*

for the sum of *One Hundred Twenty-Five (\$125.00)* Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of *One Hundred Twenty-Five (\$125.00)* Dollars to me paid by the said *D. E. Massey*

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *D. E. Massey*

"All that certain tract, piece or parcel of land lying and being situate in Greenville County and State of South Carolina, on Branch waters of North Fork of Saluda River, and is part of the Callahan tract and runs as follows: Beginning on a pine 3x on Robertson's line near the Road leading from Flat Rock (on State Road) to Jake Pruett's; thence to white Oak 3X (conditional line) thence to a Red Oak 3X near the fence; thence due North to Jake Pruett's line of Howard tract; thence along Jake Pruett's various lines to a Hickory 3X; thence to Locust 3X on above named road; thence with Robertson's line to the beginning containing by estimation 150 acres, more or less, bounded by lands of Jacob Pruett Robertson and others, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Elizabeth Gosnell by John Gosnell by ~~John Gosnell~~ on December 23, 1876."
