NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twentyfive Hundred (\$2500.00) Dollars to me paid by the said J. B. Earle

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. B. Earle.

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in Grove Township, in the town of Grove Station, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stone near a spring, and running thence N. 79 W. 7.25 to a stake 3x; thence S. 2 E. 5.85 to a stake 3x; thence S. 84 E. 4.25 to a stake 3x; thence N. 19 E. 5.15 to a stone 3x; the beginning corner, and containing three (3) acres, more or less.
