COURT OF COMMON PLEAS

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, *The Federal Land Bank of Columbia,*

on or about the *14<sup>th</sup>* day of *September* in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirty-six* exhibited *its* complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against *Grover M. Thompson, et al.,*

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the *21<sup>st</sup>* day of *November*, 1936, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

for sale by public outcry on the *7<sup>th</sup>* day of *December* in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and *thirty-six*, did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auctions, sell and dispose of the same unto *The Federal Land Bank of Columbia*

for the sum of *One Hundred (\$100.00)* Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of *One Hundred (\$100.00)* Dollars to me paid by the said *The Federal Land Bank of Columbia*

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said *The Federal Land Bank of Columbia,*

" all that certain tract of land containing *49-78* acres, more or less, situated in *Dunklin Township,* County of *Greenville,* State of *South Carolina,* on the south prong of *Horse Creek,* waters of *Reedy River,* and on the *Pinson Road*

*Bounded on the east by the lands of J. Broadus Thompson, on the north by the lands of W. P. Thompson, on the west by lands of W. P. Thompson and R. L. Campbell and on the south by lands of Carter Ridgeway and being the same tract of land conveyed to the said G. M. Thompson by R. L. Campbell by deed dated April 12, 1920, and recorded in Vol. 49, Page 526, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.*

*The above described tract of land has such shape, metes, courses, and distances as shown by plat made by James P. Wallis, Surveyor, September 6, 1921."*
