*William Henry Robinson.*

All that piece, parcel or tract of land, situated lying or being in Cleveland  
township, in the State and County aforesaid, on Waters of Middle Saluda River, containing  
twenty-seven acres, more or less, Being plat No. 3 made by E. C. Edens, Surveyor, November  
14, 1935. Plat attached. This piece of land situated on the Jones Gap road adjoining lands  
of Carrie Robinson, Mrs. Alice Robinson Surett and Mrs. Ragsdall. Being my one fourth  
interest in the estate of my late father Harvey Robinson being part of the same land bought
