All that piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in Saluda Township, County and State aforesaid, on Beaver Dam Creek waters of the North Fork of Saluda River, adjoining lands of Waverly B. Barton and others, having the following metes and bounds; Beginning at a Chestnut on the side of the Road near a Spring; thence N. 11° E. 5.66 chs. to a sweet gum; thence N. 48 $\frac{3}{4}$  W. 18.25 to a Post Oak; thence N. 74 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 11.49 chains to Post Oak; thence N. 57 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 6.87 chains to a Spanish Oak; thence N. 74 W. 7.46 to a small Spanish Oak; thence S. 52 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 7.00 chains to a chestnut down; thence S. 31 E. 10.80 to a Birch; thence S. 32 E. 15.90 chains to stake; thence N. 59 E. 8.30 to a stake; S. 28 E. 6.50 chains to a White Oak gone; thence S. 56 E. 1.75 to a stake on Beaver Dam; thence up branch to a White Oak head of the Barnacn; thence N. 89 E. 3.90 to a Hickory; thence N. 66 E. 9.30 chains to a Sour Weed; thence North 8.50 chs. to the beginning corner.
