Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Hudson Street at the southwest corner of Hudson Street and a proposed street known as Northern Street as shown on said plat, which point is also the northeast corner of the lot of land this day conveyed by the grantor herein to Dixie Stores, Inc., and ranning thence along the northern line of said Dixie Stores. Inc. lot, which is the southern side of said proposed Northern Street, N. 54-02 W. 400 feet to a point; thence S. 35-58 W. along the western line of Dixie Stores, Inc. lot 125 feet to a point; thence N. 54-02 W. 315.8 feet to an iron pin in line of property belonging to Mayberry Land Company; thence N. 35-43 E. along line of Payberry Land Company, 615 feet to a point; thence S. 54-45 E. 196 feet along rear line of lots heretofore conveyed by the grantor herein to Mozelle Groce and J. B. Ricketts, to an iron pin; thence S. 37-00 W.221.4 feet to an iron pin near old run of Reedy River; thence S. 35-03 E. 543 feet to an iron pin in the west side of Hudson Street; thence S. 27-18 W. 95.4 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning; and being part of the land conveyed by John B. Davis to Thomas B. Whitmire by deed dated July 13, 1901, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office in Deed Book 20, page 471; said T. B. Whitmire having died on May 8, 1903, intestate and unmarried, leaving as his sole heir and distributee his sister, the said Elizabeth S. Whitmire, to whom said land descended by operation of the statute of distributions (see Apartment 73, File 48, in office of Probate Court for said County), and she having died on May 7, 1938, leaving of full force her will dated November 14, 1923, admitted to probate by said Court on May 19, 1928, and now on file in Apartment 232, File 10, this deed being executed in pursuance of powers granted in said will and in an order of Hon.
