(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Ida J. Dacus, all my undivided one-half interest in and to that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in Greenville Township, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southwest corner of the intersection of the P. & N. Railroad right-of-way with Buncombe Road, and running thence N. 81-05 W. 250.5 feet to an iron pin located near or on the corner of Buncombe Road and Pike Road; thence along Pike Road S. 7-00 E. 465 feet to an iron pin on said road; thence along Pike Road S. 15-10 E. 80.4 feet to an iron pin on the right-of-way of P. & N. Railroad; thence N. 23-1/2 E. 544 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner, the lot containing one and forty-one one hundredths ( $1 \frac{41}{100}$ ) acres, more or less, less however, those two certain tracts of land heretofore conveyed to the Textile Ice & Fuel Co. Inc., said deeds being recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in book 127 at pages 307 and 439 respectively. With these exceptions, the above described property is the same as conveyed to H. J. Dacus and R. M. Dacus by F. W. Poe Manufacturing Company by deed dated October 9, 1928, and recorded in deed book 121 at page 154.
