All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, situate on the north side of Lanneau Drive just beyond the corporate limits of the City of Greenville and being known and designated as the western half of Lot no 23 on plat of property of John J. Jenkins, made by Dalton & Neve, Engineers July, 1932, and having according to said plat which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County S. 6., in Plat Book 4, page 207, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Lanneau Drive at the joint corner of Lots 23 and 24, and running thence with the joint line of said lots N. 32° 47' E. 160 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of said lots, thence S. 50° 56' E. 32.55 feet to a point in rear line of Lot no 23, said point also being 32.55 feet from the rear corner of Lots 22 and 23, thence through center of lot 23, S. 32° 47' W. 157.95 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on north side of Lanneau Drive said pin being 32.5 feet from the corner of Lots 22 and 23, thence with the north side of Lanneau Drive N. 54° 16' W. 32.5 feet to the beginning corner.
