(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Glyde Glenn,

An undivided one-half interest of, in, and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land situated on the West side of Laurens Road in said State and County  $3\frac{1}{2}$  miles from Greenville Courthouse, containing two and one-half acres, more or less, and hath such bounds, marks, etc. as follows; viz; Beginning on a stone by 2 small black gums; thence along Laurens Road N.  $31\frac{1}{2}$  W. 5.50 to a stake; thence N.  $22\frac{1}{2}$  W. 2.38 to a stake; thence S. 43 W. 5.00 to a stone; thence S.  $51\frac{1}{2}$  E. 6.87 to a stone; thence N.  $57\frac{3}{4}$  E. 2.15 to the beginning. Being bounded by lands now or formerly owned by S. L. McBee, J. A. Tolbert, and T. L. Hunt, and being the same land conveyed to me by J. Y. Knight by deed dated August 22, 1935, and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Deed Book 176, at page 282.
