KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That The South Carolina National Bank
of Charleston,
a corporation chartered under the laws of the United States of America, and having its principal place of business at
Charleston, in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of
the sum of Not over the thousand (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee, hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Barolin B. Mosley,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate,
erected and devised in the County and State aforesaid,
in the West side of Wooddale Avenue and having the
following written said bounds to-wit:

Begins at a tree at the corner of Lot No. 212 on
the West side of Woodale Avenue and running thence
with Woodale Avenue N. 64-37 E. 140 feet to the corner of
Lot No. 213, thence N. 25-23 W. 220 feet; thence S. 64-37 W. 1
140 feet; thence S. 25-23 E. 220 feet to the point of the
beginning and being Lot No. 210 and 211 second
revision of Fugler Park Plat R. E. Dalton, March 1923.

Subject, however, to the following restrictions:

1. No part of said lot shall be used for any purpose
other than a single or multiple residence and out
buildings properly appertaining thereto.
2. No part of said lot shall be occupied by any person
or the required access except in the capacity of a servant.
3. Out buildings properly appertaining to a residence shall
be confined to the rear thereof of the lot upon which
they are built unless they shall be integral to the
residence to which they pertain.
4. No part of any residence may be built or extend
nearer to the front property lines of said lot than 35 ft.
5. No residence may be built upon any lot fronting
upon Ryd Boulevard or Park Drive which shall have
when completed a reasonable value of less than
\$4,000.00 and no residence may be built upon any lots
fronting upon Rock Creek Drive, Woodale Avenue, or
Monticello Ave. which shall when completed have
a reasonable value of less than \$3,500.00.
6. No spirituous or malt liquor shall ever be manu-
factured or sold upon said lot.
7. These restrictions are imposed for the benefit of the
grantor and may be modified by it when strict
modification is desired by him to the best interest
of all concerned.
