Coleman by deed dated March 11, 1933, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 115 at page 393.

Said interest to be at the rate of six per cent per annum, and said note small be secured to a first mortgage covering said lot, and the Vice President and Secretary of the Board of "rustees are hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of said College a fee simple deed to said lot to the said Mory Rozelle Tramme 11."
