All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, Greenville Township State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 7 as shown on plat of property of E. S. Glenn, made by C. M. Purman, Jr., Engineer, dated March 28, 1928 and recorded in the office of the R. M.
